

Conflict Minerals Statement

In alignment with our commitment to ethical business practices, human rights, and environmental responsibility, and in accordance with the requirements set forth by Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, we hereby make the following statement regarding the use of conflict minerals in our products.

1. Commitment to Conflict-Free Supply Chain

We are committed to sourcing materials responsibly and ensuring that all components and products we supply to our customers shall not contain conflict minerals from the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC). Specifically:

- We warrant that all metals used in our components and products, including gold (Au), tantalum (Ta), tungsten (W), and tin (Sn), do not originate from conflict-affected regions of the DRC or its adjoining countries, nor are they derived from sources that directly or indirectly finance or benefit non-governmental military groups or unlawful military factions.
- We are conducting and will continue to conduct due diligence throughout our supply chain to trace the origin of these minerals.
- We maintain true, accurate, and verifiable records to demonstrate compliance with this commitment.

2. Reporting and Transparency

- We commit to completing the Conflict Minerals Report in a thorough and accurate manner and to providing updated information to our customers in the event of any changes.
- We support transparency in our sourcing practices and will provide relevant documentation upon request.

3. Continuous Improvement and Compliance

- We are dedicated to the continuous improvement of our conflict minerals compliance program.
- Should our customers establish stricter requirements regarding conflict minerals, we agree to comply with those requirements and collaborate to meet their responsible sourcing standards.
